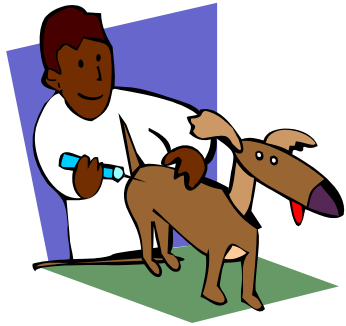


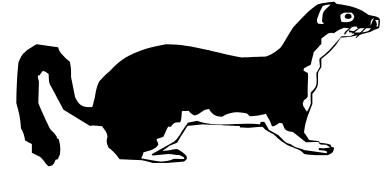
FREE RABIES CLINIC

ALL DOGS MUST BE ON A LEASH OR SECURELY CONFINED. ALL CATS AND FERRETS MUST BE SECURELY CONFINED. ALL PETS MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY A RESPONSIBLE ADULT WHO IS ABLE TO HOLD THE PET DURING VACCINATION.

- **Young pets:** Puppies, kittens, and young ferrets **must be at least 3 months of age.**
- **Initial vaccines** are effective for only one year. Pets must be re-vaccinated one year after initial vaccination.
- **Previously vaccinated dogs & cats:** Bring proof of vaccination to the clinic to receive a rabies certificate that is good for 3 years*. If no proof provided, the certificate will expire in one year.
- **Ferret vaccinations:** Ferrets must be vaccinated annually.
- **Pregnant or nursing animals:** May not be vaccinated if attending veterinarian refuses.
- **Duplicate certificates:** Duplicate certificates may be purchased at the Chemung County Health Department for a **fee of \$10.00.** Certificates are needed for licensing, interstate travel and accurate record keeping.
- **Routine veterinary care** is recommended for all pets.
- **If special assistance is needed at the clinic, please call 737-2019 to register a few days prior to the clinic**
