ALL DOGS MUST BE ON A LEASH OR SECURELY CONFINED. ALL CATS AND FERRETS MUST BE SECURELY CONFINED. ALL PETS MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY A RESPONSIBLE ADULT WHO IS ABLE TO HOLD THE PET DURING VACCINATION.

- Young pets: Puppies, kittens, and ferrets must be at least 3 months of age.
- **Initial vaccinations** are effective for only one year. Pets must be re-vaccinated one year after initial vaccination.
- **Previously vaccinated dogs & cats:** Bring proof of vaccination to the clinic to receive a rabies certificate that is good for 3 years*. If no proof provided, the certificate will expire in one year.
- **Ferret vaccinations:** Ferrets must be vaccinated annually.
- Clinics are for New York State residents only.
- Vaccinations are FREE, but donations are greatly appreciated!

* REMEMBER TO BRING PROOF OF PREVIOUS VACCINATION FOR YOUR CAT OR DOG in order to receive a rabies certificate good for 3 years.
