



How do I register to vote?

ONLINE

You can now register to vote online using the online voter registration portal!



IN PERSON

You can use a paper voter registration application at your county's Board of Elections or any state agency designated as a National Voter Registration Act site. Sites include DMV, SUNY, CUNY, Department of Health, Office of Temporary & Disability Assistance, and more.

BY MAIL

You can complete and mail a paper voter registration application to your county's Board of Elections.

New Yorkers can register to vote up to 10 days before any election.
