APPOINTMENTS ARE REQUIRED FOR GRIEVANCE and MUST BE MADE PRIOR TO MAY 20, 2023. Email or call the Assessor's office to schedule. The Board of Assessment Review will meet on Wednesday, May 24, 2023 at the Town Hall, 1139 Pennsylvania Avenue Elmira, NY between the hours of 3:00 PM and 5:00 PM and 6:00 PM and 8:00 PM to hear and examine all scheduled/filed complaints in relation to assessment on the application of any person believing himself to be aggrieved. If you wish to have your complaint reviewed by mail, RP524 and supporting documentation must be received by the Assessor's office prior to May 24<sup>th</sup>, 2023.

Complaint form RP524 and supporting documents for scheduled appointments must be filed with the Assessor by May 20, 2023. Publication containing procedures for contesting an assessment and complaint form RP524 are available online at <http://www.tax.ny.gov>, or by contacting the assessor. Attendance with your complaint is not necessary to have it heard; only the timely filing of the completed complaint form.
