Under discussion are quotes for asbestos removal and demolition of 15 Kneale Road. Code Enforcement Officer Peter Rocchi stated that there is asbestos in the building which limits the Town Highway Department's ability to demolish the property. Mr. Rocchi contacted the LCP group to get a quote on demolition and is waiting to hear from them. Supervisor Sheen stated he is going to contact someone at the County level to see if Casella can take the materials once the building is demolished as a cost savings. This will be tabled until the October meeting.

Under Taxpayer's Comments, Charles Collins from 436 Kinner Hill Road spoke regarding all appointed boards having open meetings so citizens can speak. He commended Mike Stephens, Planning Board Chairman for allowing citizens to speak at all Planning Board Meetings.

Mike Stephens, Planning Board Chairman spoke in regards to public comment and Planning Board Meetings.

Mr. Stephens also spoke regarding the Southport Trails Committee and that he attended a webinar on alternative transportation. He also stated that he is working on a grant application and asked the Town Board for some technical assistance in writing the grant application.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town Board of the Town of Southport in regular session duly convened does hereby agree to hire a consultant to assist with the preparation of a grant for the Hike Bike Trail along Seeley Creek in an amount not to exceed TWO THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$2,500.00).
