WHEREAS, the New York State Department of Transportation is requesting municipalities to enter into shared service agreements to allow for assistance during times of emergencies when municipal resources related to highway services become exhausted, and

WHEREAS, with the shared services agreement in place the Town will be able to access State resources without the Governor declaring a state of emergency and services can be shared in a faster and more efficient manner.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town Board of the Town of Southport hereby authorizes the Town Highway Superintendent to enter into the shared service agreement with the New York State Department of Transportation for highway related services, equipment, and material dated March 15, 2017.

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Under Discussion was Medical Insurance. A discussion was held concerning health insurance for retirees and future retirees. The need to put in effect a ceiling for what the Town pays for the premium of each retiree and spouse was discussed. It was tabled to the April meeting.

There was a concern that the limit being paid by the Town be reviewed at various times in the future and this concern be put in the resolution.

Discussion was also about whether part-time Council Members and Judges be eligible for medical insurance in the future. It was decided to table this issue to later in the year, as changes if any, would come at the end of the year and new rates may play a part also.
