Discussion was held regarding the 2021 Tentative Budget.

The Town Board discussed expenditures and revenues and the challenges related to developing a budget for 2021. These factors include:

- 1. Loss of revenue due to COVID-19.
- 2. County sales tax redistribution for 2021 (63.3% County/36.7% municipalities) and 2022 (66.7% County/33.3% municipalities).
- 3. Need to replace aging highway equipment and make infrastructure investments.
- 4. Outstanding flood recovery money from 2018 and 2019.
