Linda Palmer from 915 Laurel Street spoke regarding property tax increases over the past two years and feels the Town should have notified the residents why this occurred.

Supervisor Roman commented the following on the 2024 budget:

- 1. Comparisons to previous years of Town budgets and review of Monthly Reports of the Supervisor.
- 2. Review of income and expense, balance sheet, and detail reports from Williamson Law Book Company.
- 2. Research pertaining to economic forecasts for 2024.
- 3. The possibility of a weaker economy potentially impacting revenues and expenses.
- 4. Adjusting property tax and sales tax revenues.
- 5. A conservative approach to all revenue streams.
- 6. Focus on maintaining and supporting service levels from all departments.
- 7. Disciplined approach to costs increasing necessary budget lines while controlling and/or reducing costs in others.
- 8. Consideration of debt service payments.
- 9. Cautious and diligent use of American Rescue Plan Funding.
- 10. Maintenance and upgrades of the Town's assets including buildings, infrastructure, and equipment.
- 11. Creating a balanced budget with the goal of increasing fund balances.

Council Member Gunderman made a motion, Council Member Steed seconded to adjourn the meeting.
